### **Rummage Sale**

July is coming up (or here, depending upon when you read this), and that means it is Rummage Sale time. The annual rummage sale for the Day School has had a significant impact on the school. Playground equipment upgrades, teacher bonuses, and other items are made possible by the money raised with the rummage sale.

The Day School is a ministry of the parish that largely pays for itself. It is not a separate entity. The rummage sale is one of the main ways that the day school is able to do so much for the children entrusted to its care.


