Holy Week 2024

This year, our Holy Week and Easter observances fall in March, but just barely. They are in the last week of March, so you have plenty of time after reading this to make plans to attend.

Holy Week begins March 24 with the Sunday of the Passion. We will start the service, weather permitting, in the courtyard with the Liturgy of the Palms. This liturgy commemorated our Lord's "Triumphal Entry" into Jerusalem. It is a joyful occasion that turns on a dime as we approach the doors to the church and the emphasis shifts to the Passion theme. We go from shouting "Hosannah!" to shouting "Crucify him!" It is jarring, and that is by intention. The crowd turned on our Lord in a very short time, persuaded by nefarious persons in the religious leadership who perceived our Lord not as a Savior but as a threat.

Holy Week continues on Wednesday with the Stations of the Cross. Pilgrims to the Holy Land would follow Jesus' path from Gabbatha to Golgotha and the grave. We will simulate this journey going around the nave, making stops at points both biblical and traditional. At each station, there is a short meditation and prayer as we contemplate our Lord's journey to the cross.

On Thursday we will observe Maundy Thursday. There is a three-fold emphasis to this day: (a) the institution of the Holy Eucharist; (b) the law of love, symbolized by the washing of feet; and (c) the beginning of the celebration of the Passion and Death of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Paschal Triduum.

The Triduum continues on Good Friday as we gather at noon to remember the Crucifixion of our Lord. This can be a very moving and powerful service, and I encourage all who possibly can to attend.

Saturday is the Great Vigil of Easter. This is the focus of the entire liturgical year. We will begin at 7:30 PM in the courtyard as the sun sets. We light a new fire and from it the Paschal candle. We process into the darkened nave by its light. The ancient hymn, the *Exsultet*, is chanted as the light of Christ spreads through the darkened nave. We hear readings from the Old Testament teaching about God's salvation. Next, if we have a candidate, we will have a baptism. If there are no candidates, *(continued on page 2)*

(continued from page 1) we will simply renew our baptismal vows. Then we turn up the lights, rings bells, and celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord. It is a glorious service. The celebration will be followed by a gala reception in the parish hall.

Holy Week and Easter are the high points of the liturgical year, and I encourage you to come to as many services as you can.





Coats for 65 foster children \$2,332.10

Beds and Bedding for at-risk children: 10 sets of bunk beds with

Comforter sets and pillows \$6,148.72

Total \$17,517.30

In addition, AC provided Christmas gifts (4 -5 gifts per child) for 65 foster children. The children and their foster families along with Washington County social workers were given a Christmas party including a meal and entertainment. We also provided filled Christmas stockings for 163 in-home children plus food vouchers for 50 families.




