Betsy will be on vacation June 3 - 7. She will be back in the office June 10.



Robertshaw Scholarship

The Robertshaw Scholarship is a one-time scholarship for a graduating senior. It was established in 1980 in memory of James Robertshaw, Jr. who, suffering from the severest of physical handicaps and in the knowledge of certain death from muscular debilitation, nevertheless exhibited the highest quality of courage and perseverance in achieving high levels of scholarship and never gave up. Therefore, the key criteria for nominees is to have shown courage, perseverance, scholarship and creativeness in their high school career.

The wardens and rector have awarded 2 Robertshaw scholarships for 2024.

Travary Hart from St. Joe and Faith O'Neal from Greenville High each received a \$5,000.00 scholarship for their higher education.
