The arrival of July at St. James' means it is Rummage Sale time. The Rummage Sale is one of the biggest parish-wide efforts we do here in the parish along with Bazaar and the Annis' Children Christmas Party. What I love about all three is that they are huge efforts put on by the parish that do not directly benefit the parish.

Granted, the proceeds from the Rummage Sale go to fund extrabudgetary activities for the Day School, these things benefit the children and teachers of the Day School, the majority of whom are not members of St. James'. The tuition for the Day School covers teachers' salaries and such, but the Rummage Sale makes it possible to offer more "bang for their buck" such as playground equipment and special events through the year.

In my ten years here at St. James', I am constantly impressed and humbled by the generosity of her members in time, talent, and treasure. Folks here genuinely care for each other and for those outside our parish family. It is wonderful to be part of a parish that cares.
